Thank you for your interest in becoming a SCRPC contractor or vendor. SCRPC's Home Repair Program is looking to make new connections with contractors and vendors for residential home repair.

MWBE and Section 3 contractors are highly encouraged to apply.

Initial Contractor eligibility requirements

- Two references listing the projects name and owners contact information, location, description of work perform and the projects value.
- Awarded projects will require general liability insurance coverage in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 Aggregate (**Required at the time of contract signing**)
- Awarded projects will require Proof of Workers' Compensation covering employees and subcontractors. CE-200s are not acceptable. All contractors must carry Workers Compensation. * Additional certifications and insurances may be required. (**Required at the time of contract signing**)
- If you are interested in receiving email notifications of projects that are available for bidding, please print and complete the **Contractors Qualification Registration Form** below. Once approved, you will receive a confirmation email, a Contractor Program Summary, and be added to our email group notification list.

Manufactured Home Replacement Program in Schoharie County

The Schoharie County Rural Preservation Corporation is accepting applications for mobile home replacement assistance in Schoharie County (several townships excluded). Schoharie County Rural Preservation Corporation has received federal grants through the NYS Home Local Program- Housing Trust Fund Corporation.

General eligibility is based on gross household income at or below 80% of the area median income, ownership in the name of the applicant and home is in poor condition.

Additional requirements for properties: mobile home is permanent, year-round residence of owner/applicant, applicant has no outstanding liens or mortgages, and are current on all property taxes, lot rent and utilities.

Successful applicants will be included on a database and scored on the program eligibility criteria. There is a waiting list but applicants are placed on a list for future funding rounds as they become available.

Septic System Program

If your septic system is beyond repair and in need of replacement, the Schoharie County Rural Preservation Corp. (SCRPC) may be able to help.

The SCRPC in collaboration with the Schoharie County Office of Planning & Community Development Services is applying for a Community Development Block grant that will assist low to moderate income homeowners with the replacement of their septic system.

Note: The home must be the homeowners' residence and the homeowner must execute a deferred, forgivable 5 year note & mortgage to ensure compliance with the grant. Applicants must meet income guidelines.
